# What is jQuery?

jQuery is a JavaScript library that makes DOM manipulation, animation, styling, event handling, and user interface creation a breeze.

It is open source and free to use.

# Format

`$(selector)`- Mostly the same as CSS selectors

- tag, .class, #id, input[type=text]
- All variables begin with \$

`.event()`- used to call functions on an event

- Essentially the same as JavaScript syntax

All regular javascript is fair game in jQuery, too!

# But before we start...

You must include the jQuery library in the head, and you must use jQuery wrappers.

```
<script src="//ajax.googleapis.com/ajax/libs/jquery/1.9.1/jquery.min.js"></script>
<script type="text/javascript">
$(document).ready(function() {
    // All of your jQuery code goes here
})
</script>
```

# Getting and Setting Content

.html()  
.attr()

Can be used to retrieve  
or set content.

```
var content = $('#myDiv').html();
var link = $('a#myLink').attr('href');

$('#myDiv').html('<p>Text</p>');
$('a#myLink').attr('href', 'http://google.com');
```

# Styling / The Class Attribute

.addClass()

.removeClass()

.css

```
$('#myElement).addClass('active')
```

```
$('#myElement).css('color', 'red')
```

# Events

.click()  
.hover()  
.change()  
.blur() / .focus()  
.submit()

.on()  
.on('click') = .click()

```
$('#myLink).click(function() {  
    // Javascript to execute  
})
```

# Displaying Content

.show()

.slideDown()

.hide()

.slideUp()

.fadeIn()

.toggle()

.fadeOut()

```
$('#myLink').click(function() {
```

```
  $('#myContent').toggle();
```

```
)}
```

jQuery UI is a set of themes, effects, and widgets that help you easily create an elegant user interface.

# jQuery UI

Some examples:

`$('.tabs').tabs()`

`$('.datepicker').datepicker()`

`$('.slider').slider()`

`$('.button').button()`
