Executive Summary

URscheduler serves as an all-in-one tool where students are able to not only find the standard course descriptions and information, but also are able to view student reviews of the professor, reviews of the course, and build their schedule.

Choosing the best courses and professors is a rite of passage for every student. URscheduler aims to aid students to create the best possible experience for curriculum building at the University of Rochester.

Use Case 1: Teachers Pet

Student Billy takes ECO108 and loved Professor Rizzo's class. Although he is a Chemical Engineering Major, he definitely wants to take more classes with Rizzo and wants to potentially cluster in this field.

Using SchedulUR Billy can find other classes that Rizzo teaches and see how they compare to this first ECO108 class he enjoyed. During his search, he can also see if his desired class is compatible with a cluster. If Billy finds a class that he wants to take, he can either bookmark the class for later or add it to his schedule.
