Do people play like that? McDermott: Maybe yes; Chess experts: No!

Backgammon - checkers-like, but allowable moves depend on dice (=>uncertainty)

NN-based system, TD-gammon, beats human players. ... are nonsymbolic methods better than symbolic ones? McDermott: That's a false distinction! "GOFAI"

- Many "GOFAI" symbols have no external meaning - NNI's are generally programmed on "symbolic" machines - states of NN (or organic) systems can often be viewed as meaninful in relation to the world

The vision & speech-enabled "David" agent (Georgiy Platonov, Ben Kane, et al.)



Note the Kinect cameras, which build up a geometric model of the blocks on the table, & these are in turn used to build a 3D model using "Blender" graphics. "David" can answer spatial relation questions.

· Computer vision

- point detectors, edgel detectors, color/texture detectors much as in our eyes; connect into curves, surfaces, ... - correlation (depth perception) - optical flow: self-motion, distance, object motion

- motion control, for many-degree-of-freedom systems (taking account of kinematics, dynamics)
- vision integrate depth maps (from stored) from - problems with dead reckoning

In 2 or more dimensions, we have Z unknowns, Vx & Vy, & still only one equation. So extra mathematical constraints are needed, e.g., correlations (maximize cross-correlations)
